What is the title and theme of our campaign and why was it chosen?

“Offer Them Christ – Every Generation Has A Work Of God To Do” expresses the heart of our campaign. “Offer Them Christ” is part of the KIUMC mission statement. In our first capital campaign Rev. Roy Phillips shared with us that “every generation has a work of God to do.” In choosing the theme, we acknowledge the opportunity for each of us to support what God is doing through this church in the present and into the future.



What is the purpose of the “Offer Them Christ” campaign?

The purpose of the campaign is twofold:

1. To understand our need for this expanded facility as an opportunity for all of us to be involved in the work of this generation.
2. To understand the cost of this new construction and to have each of us prayerfully consider how we will respond.



What is our debt on the Phillips Building?

The cost is significant. With the completion of the Rev. Roy B. Phillips Memorial Building, our church will have incurred debt of approximately \$3.75 million.



What is our mortgage payment?

To simply manage the debt, we will have to make monthly payments of approximately \$25,000 for 30 years. It would certainly be our aim to pay down that debt in less time. Our goal is to raise over and above so that the mortgage can be paid off in less time.
