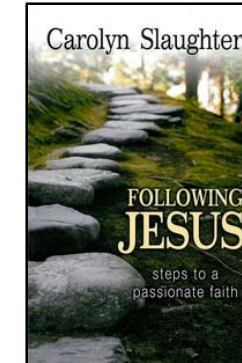


KIUMC Weekly Prayer Focus for Renewal and Revival

FJ 5b: Wednesdays at 7pm

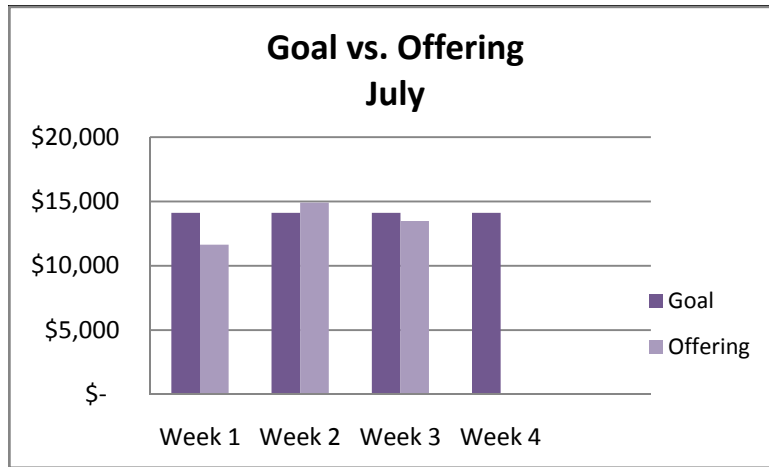
