### Man to Man

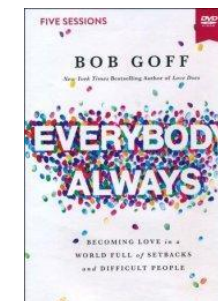

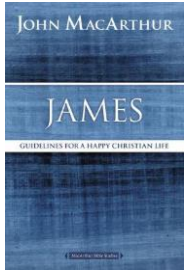


## Healing Prayer-Level II
