Position Summary

The Evening Custodian is a part-time position that will partner with the Ministry Support Focus Area to insure the KIUMC grounds and facilities are maintained at a high level of appearance, cleanliness, safety and working order in order to facilitate ministry that will help KIUMC to fulfill their vision to Grow in Christ, transform families and change the world.

Essential Functions and Responsibilities

1. Clean daily all rooms, remove trash, clean bathrooms, and water fountains, located in the Education and Phillips Buildings. Clean the Sanctuary as needed.
2. Clean halls and stairwells as needed.
3. Make sure each room scheduled for evening use is properly set up, unlocked and at the proper temperature.
4. Set up morning activities as directed by Facilities Manager.
5. Lock all exterior doors before leaving at the end of evening shift.

Core Competencies

5. **Personal Resilience:** Can effectively cope with change and uncertainty; can shift gears comfortably; can decide and act without having the total picture; isn't upset when things are up in the air; can comfortably handle risk and uncertainty; is flexible.
