## March Healing Service



The Healing Service was held on March 25th at 7:00 pm. The speaker was Cathy Timms, who shared about her struggle with judgment and self-inflicted guilt and shame. These caused deep scars and wounds in her being. She needed to find her true spiritual identify, which means understanding that as a Christian, we are defined by God alone. From Galatians 4:7 – You are no longer a slave, but a son (daughter)... We first have a physical birth and then a spiritual birth where we are reborn. From Cathy's notes, "Our identity, how God relates to us, is rooted in our (second) birth – not our performance." This was a very important message and one with which everyone struggles. Music was provided by the Celebrate Recovery Band. About 45 people attended for communion and healing prayer.

We invite you to share in the warmth of our healing service with a time of praise, a message, communion, and healing prayer at the rail.
